Teston Road, Offham

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & TEMPORARY 30 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2023

To allow duct installation works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic & impose a temporary mandatory 30 mph speed restriction on part of Teston Road, Offham.

A temporary mandatory 30 mph speed restriction with two-way traffic lights will be imposed on Teston Road, Offham from 1st August 2023, with estimated completion by 29th January 2024.

The 30 mph speed restriction will be in place from the entrance to Spadework to the junction with B2016 Seven Mile Lane.

Teston Road, Offham will be closed from 12th September 2023, with estimated completion by 18th October 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (YF089EXA-000108-02 - I-21 Holdings Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

The road will be closed between Pepingstraw Close and Aldon Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2016 Seven Mile Lane, A20 London Road, Ashton Way, A228 Ashton Way, King Hill, Teston Road and vice versa.

The restrictions are required for the safety of the public and workforce while duct installation works are undertaken by I-21 Holdings Ltd.
